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Your Past Practice Information

Because medical indemnity claims or investigations can first be notified to you years after you have provided the relevant healthcare service, it is vital that at all times you are covered for your past practice through sufficient retroactive cover. Further, since 1 January 2016, medical practitioners are required to have appropriate retroactive cover in accordance with a revised registration standard of the Medical Board of Australia. The retroactive date of your insurance policy is the date from which your past work will be covered (unless you know or should have known that a claim might result from an incident or an incident is otherwise covered e.g. you have already notified the incident to your insurer or you are indemnified for the incident by a hospital or other employer). If you move insurers, Doctors' Choice helps you make the switch so you have continuous cover in place. Your current insurance policy will indicate your retroactive date which we will obtain from your current insurer.
